Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Friday 16th August Kindergarten students are invited to attend an excursion to explore and discover some important natural, man made and historical landmarks in the Broulee and Mossy Point areas.

The excursion will include a visit to the following locations:

- The Canoe Tree at Broulee.
- The Tomaga river
- The boat ramp at Mossy Point
- The anchor at Mossy Point headland.
- Mossy Point headland
- Candlagan Creek and bridge
- North Broulee beach

This excursion links to both our Term 2 Science unit 'Bridges and Beyond' - investigating properties of materials, design and construction, and our Term 3 History & Geography unit "Zoom" investigating identity, place and belonging. This excursion addresses the following outcomes:

- Demonstrates developing skills of historical inquiry and communication HTe-2
- Identifies places and develops an understanding of the importance of places to people GEe-1
- Communicates geographical information and uses geographical tools GEe-2
- Identifies how daily and seasonal changes in the environment affect humans and other living things STe-6ES-S
- Identifies that objects are made of materials that have observable properties STe-4MW-ST
- Explores the characteristics, needs and uses of living things STe-3LW-LT

Bernadette Davies from Eurobodalla Council will be our guide for the morning. **We will be leaving school by bus at 9.15 am on Friday 16 th August and returning around 1.10 pm.**

Children are required to wear full school uniform including comfortable walking shoes and a broad brimmed hat. Students will need to bring fresh fruit/vegetables for 'Crunch and Sip' break, a water bottle and their lunch.

Bernadette has requested children bring an Earth friendly lunch, (no plastic wrap, chip packets etc. and no single use drink containers).

Parents are welcome to join us but will need to provide their own transport.

The cost for the bus will be **\$3** per student and **payable by Friday 9th August 2019.**
